- I. Call to Order—Mona Crider, Board Chair
- II. Old Business
 - A. Southern Land project update Jeremy Cyr
 - 1. Asbestos removal will begin this week
 - 2. Demo will begin after that, will go through mid-March
 - 3. Parking should not have too much disruption
 - 4. May-June will be the time when actual construction will start
 - 5. Still working with the City on logistics with alley access
 - 6. Parking structure will be first to be built
 - 7. Parking garage may be accessible a couple months before construction is complete
 - 8. Traffic should not be affected
 - 9. Parking by McCall Plaza will not be affected
 - 10. Plano Fire Department has decided they **will not** need the crosswalk between Angela's and La Foofaraw for an emergency egress lane
 - 11. Discussed alternative route for deliveries
 - B. Public Safety Report Officer Chris Semrau, Plano Police Department
 - 1. Incidents and arrests
 - a. Seven arrests in January, pretty standard for one month
 - b. PSO patrol for marking tires
 - c. Soliciting is a problem in Dallas right now, be on the look out
 - d. There have been a handful of opportunity crimes, be cautious
 - e. Would like to see an increase camera usage on businesses
 - C. Facilities Report
 - 1. Exterior Lighting Repairs Alex Hargis, Executive Director
 - a. All lights are fixed as well as shorts
 - D. Parking Report City of Plano Representative
 - 1. Lloyd Neal, Transportation Engineer, Parking Study
 - a. Looked at current date and ten years into the future
 - b. Typically there is availability one block away
 - c. Refusal to walk that block
 - d. Slight underage of about 85 stalls
 - e. Looking at options to share private stalls
 - f. Would like to refine sizing of parking garage
 - g. Considering valet and shared parking
 - h. Looked at timed parking, patrons turn over every 3 hours on average
 - i. Study will be available planotraffic.org on February 8th
 - j. Public meeting February 16, 6:00 pm, Municipal Center

- k. Frank Turner feels there can be 50 additional spaces added to DART lot, though that would still be several months away
- I. Employees should park far from businesses allowing customers best parking
- m. May come up with some kind of incentive to use DART
- n. Working on making a valet space at McCall Plaza
- o. Use of City parking lots during weekend is recommended
- E. Cleaning of Street Lamps City of Plano representative
 - 1. Peter Braster, City is working on them now, should be finished any day
- F. Utility project on 15th St. Pl City of Plano representative
 - 1. Peter Braster, Oncor finally got transformer moved, does not have a timetable though
